

Haverhill Relief Road

Community Update

Welcome to your latest update from Persimmon Homes Suffolk on the Haverhill Relief Road, which we are delivering in conjunction with Suffolk County Council and West Suffolk Council.

Construction progress

During the recent period of warm weather the project team working on this £9.7m upgrade have been able to forge ahead with drainage works for the new Haverhill Relief Road.

Drainage works along the eastern section of the road, marked in yellow, are now complete. The kerbs have been installed between Haverhill Road and the central roundabout, and asphalt road surfacing is due to start from 24 July. This will complete the base course for this section of the road.

Embankments have been formed along this section and top soil has been laid. There are now discussions taking place over coordinating landscaping ahead of the planting season in the autumn.

Drainage works are now underway along the central section, marked in blue, and once complete the base course can start to be laid.

We are working with a range of contractors on this complex engineering project, including Anglian Water. They are currently working on diverting the water main and are due to complete this element of the project by the middle of July.

A gas diversion along the final section of the road, shown in purple, is due to start at the end of August, once the base course for the blue section is complete.



Future updates and monitoring

Persimmon Homes Suffolk continues to work with representatives from both Suffolk County Council and West Suffolk Council to review progress on a monthly basis to ensure the project remains on track for completion in spring 2024.

We will continue to share regular updates about the Haverhill Relief Road with residents as we understand this is a major project for the town and one you want to stay up-to-date with.

New Signage

A new sign planned for Hales Barn End is yet to be installed as we are awaiting the digging of trial holes, needed to ensure this does not interfere with existing services. We will provide an update in our next briefing.
