Kedington Parish Council is working with Suffolk Local History Council to try and find a willing volunteer to be the Local History Recorder for Kedington and Calford Green.

This position is unpaid but it is not expected that it will be too arduous. You will be contributing to the history of this wonderful village and receive the full support of the Parish Council and Suffolk Local History Council.

The Suffolk Local History Council runs a Recorders Scheme throughout Suffolk. We administer a network of volunteers to ensure that the '*present*' is adequately recorded at local level for the '*future*'.

A Recorder will note significant happenings in their parish and collect their local parish magazines, leaflets, election pamphlets and newspaper cuttings. At the end of each year, they are asked to submit a short report summarising the activities of their parish. The reports are deposited at the Suffolk Record Office and available to future researchers together with the collected items.

You do not need to be a historian; you do not need any qualifications other than an interest in your parish. In return you will receive a copy of the SLHC Newsletter and be invited to the annual conference specifically for Local Recorders.
